BORN: 10 Mar. 1812 McConnellstown, Huntington County, Pennsylvania, the son of George Denig²

Died: 4 Sept. 1858 White Horse Plains, Assiniboia³

BETSY L'ASSINIBOINE

BORN: 1822 (Assiniboine native)⁴

The children of Edwin Thompson Denig and Betsy L'Assiniboine

Born: 10 Aug. 1845 Territory of Missouri, United States⁶

Married: To Augustin Carriere,⁷ born 1840 St. Boniface, Assiniboia and the metis son of Andre Carriere (metis) and Marie Ann Rivard (metis)⁸
