second time to Rosalie Lepine,<sup>21</sup> born 2 Jan. 1849 St. Boniface, Assiniboia and the metis daughter of Baptiste Lepine (metis) and Isabelle Parenteau (metis).<sup>22</sup> He died 28 Jan. 1907 Outarde Lake, Saskatchewan.<sup>23</sup> She was married a second time to Godfrey Lagemonier,<sup>24</sup> born 1842-1847 Red River Settlement, Assiniboia and the metis son of Romain Lagemonier and Marie Vandry (metis).<sup>25</sup> He died 27 Sept. 1874 St. Boniface, Assiniboia.<sup>26</sup>
