 A. Fort Calgary
- What was the name of the wife of D.W. Davis?
 A. Natoyist-siksina, or Revenge Walker
- 3. In 1888, what newspaper did D.W. Davis and a group of partners buy? *A. Calgary Herald*
- How old was Mother Mary Greene when she came to Western Canada?
 A. 40 years old
- Who promised to protect Mother Mary Greene during the North-West Rebellion in March of 1885?
 A. Louis Riel
- 6. What was the name of the book Captain John Palliser published in 1853?A. Solitary Rambles and Adventures of a Hunter in the Prairies
- 7. Where is the region known as Palliser's Triangle?
 - A. Southern Alberta (south of Red Deer) and into southwestern Saskatchewan
- 8. From what organization did Captain John Palliser win a gold medal in 1859?
 - A. Royal Geographical Society
- What nickname did David Thompson earn due to his daily astronomical observations?
 A. Koo Koo Sint or "Star Gazer"
- 10. How old was David Thompson when he left Britain for Canada? A. 13 years old
