

Student Knowledge Hunt – Mounties Questions and Answers

As an introductory activity to the *Mavericks: An Incorrigible History of Alberta* web site, students may take five to ten minutes to become familiar with the site and answer the specific questions they have been provided.

- 1. Why did the Canadian government create the NWMP in 1873?
 - A. To establish Canadian sovereignty over the vast new territories of the North-West and to end the whisky trade
- 2. Name three forts that the NWMP established in Western Canada.
 - A. Fort Macleod, Fort Calgary, and Fort Walsh
- 3. In what year did the NWMP begin to deal with problems due to the gold rush?
 - A. 1896
- 4. Why did King Edward add the prefix "Royal" to the RNWMP?
 - A. In recognition of their services in South Africa during the Boer War
- 5. What name was Jerry Potts known as among Native people?
 - A. Ky-yo-kosi or Bear Child
- 6. What was Jerry Potts job during the historic signing of Treaty No. 7 at Blackfoot Crossing?
 - A. Interpreter
- 7. On what date were James MacLeod and Mary Drever finally married?
 A. July 28, 1876
- 8. What member of the monarchy did James and Mary MacLeod meet in 1882?
 - A. The Marquis of Lorne and his wife Princess Louise Caroline Alberta
- 9. How old was Fred Bagley when he joined the NWMP?
 - A. 15 years old
- 10. What rank was Fred Bagley when he retired from the NWMP in 1898?
 - A. Sergeant-major
