

Essential Questions: Newcomers

Questions:

- Why would immigrants leave their original homes to come to a new place?
- Should we accept any and all immigrants if they want to come to Canada?
- What would it be like to move to a new country?
- Do we treat all people equally?
- Should immigrants to Canada be forced to learn English?
- Should immigrants to Canada adopt Canadian traditions and put aside their old ones?
- How does migration affect Canada and the countries immigrants leave behind?
